what to expect

your micro wedding will be an intimate and sophisticated affair that feels special and uniquely personal to you as a couple. the slow pace of the small celebration will enable you to enjoy and appreciate each moment and connect with every guest.

a micro wedding is a safe wedding, and it is our highest priority to ensure all CDC and state guidelines are met. Below are some examples of the safety precautions that will take place at your micro wedding:



the location

- venue options largely depend on the timing of your event in connection with the phases of Pennsylvania's reopening plan. As we move into later phases, more venues will be available for rental and city parks will be open for small gatherings.
- your chosen location must provide adequate space for your guests and on-site wedding vendors to maintain 6ft of distance at all times. if you are planning an at-home wedding, we will need to determine in advance whether your space can support your desired guest count.

photography + film

- we highly recommend taking traditional group portraits only with the family and friends with whom you have been sheltering in place! depending on the layout of your venue, your photographer may be able to take a wide shot of your entire group together.

on-site vendors

- your on-site wedding vendors (photographer, cinematographer, coordinator and officiant) will remain a safe 6ft distance from you and your guests at all times. they will also be wearing a mask and gloves.
